Randy & Marge Hall invite you to attend the 2024 fall tour headquartered at the Hampton Inn located at 205 Old Bartow/Eagle Lake Road, Bartow, FL.

On Thursday, a group welcome dinner will be held at a nearby local restaurant, order off the menu, self pay..

On Friday morning we'll travel to Lakeland, FL skirting the shoreline of some of the lakes that give Lakeland its name. Our first stop in Lakeland will be the **Ashley Gibson Barnett Museum of Art** at Florida Southern College. Next up, the **Hollis Garden** featuring the Frances Langford promenade on beautiful Lake Mirror. There are two options for lunch: The Garden Bistro in Hollis Garden is a small venue with indoor and outdoor seating overlooking the lake. The second is the Terrace Grill located 2 blocks away in the 1920s vintage Terrace Hotel. In the afternoon, we'll visit Florida Southern College featuring 13 Frank Lloyd Wright structures. During a 1-1/2 hour docent led tour you will see the genius and folly of America's most well known architect. Round trip, about 60 miles

On Saturday it's off to **the Florida Air Museum** at the Lakeland Linder International Airport. The museum is designated as Florida's "official aviation museum and education center." It features a display of aircraft including one-of-a-kind designs, classics, ultra-lights, antiques and warbirds. These exhibits bring stories to life and create amazing interactive learning experiences exploring aviation one adventure at a time. Their annual "Wings and Things" family event is happening on campus during our visit and the Air Museum is open with free admission. Lunch will be a short drive away at **Lakeside Village** where several restaurant options are available. From there we travel to Mulberry where we'll visit the **Mulberry Phosphate Museum** in the original railroad depot. Exhibits include fossils, memorabilia, and exhibits about the phosphate mining industry. We will learn all about phosphate and why it is essential in our world today. From there we'll drive to and through **Streamsong Golf Resort** situated on thousands of acres of stunning scenery and hushed seclusion in central Florida. Streamsong is a one-of-a-kind destination created in complete harmony with its natural surroundings. Round trip, about 85 miles

On Sunday members **Roseanne & Dan Gernatt** will welcome us to their Lake Wales home to see their Florida car collection. Lunch will be available at **Cherry Pocket Steak 'n Seafood** established in 1940, Dan's go-to lunch destination. Round trip, about 50 mi
